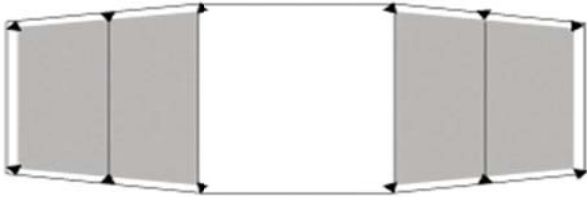


D.R. Strategies: Skydd Tent Instructions

Step 1: Assemble the shock-corded poles and unroll the orange outer shell of the tent. Lay out the shell on a flat surface

Step 2: Feed the poles through their designated sleeves and stake out corners of tent

Note: The two longer poles go in the inner sleeves (near the middle of the tent); the two shorter poles go in the outer sleeves

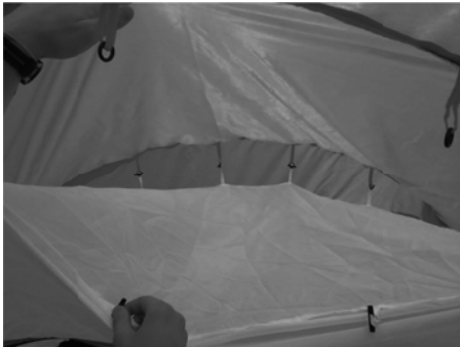


Step 3: Erect the structure, starting with the middle poles; put the ends of poles into each corresponding loop attached to the straps that go along the ground and stake the loop to the ground



Step 4: Attach guy-lines at each point and stake them out. Be sure to tension each line to support the tent. Properly tensioned lines will keep the tent very stable despite moderate wind

Step 5: Lay out the first room inside its alcove. Feed the plastic catches through each loop in the tent shell to hang the room, starting with the back row of catches. Stake out the base of the floor while keeping it completely beneath the outer shell. Repeat for the other room if desired.



Step 6: If desired, assemble the two aluminum poles and insert them into each of the door corner loops. Anchor them with additional guy-lines.
